NZ 898 108 what3words Afterwards, a bat walk from around 9pm from the pub, either along the Cinder Track and footpath towards Ruswarp or up the steps and around the Abbey grounds. Sunday 25 th 10.30am	Skinningrove Park by St Helen's Church NZ 897114 what3words TS13 4ES	Leaders HK and GJ. A walk via meadow, along cliffs and down to the beach.
Sunday 25 th 9 pm	Possible Nightjar trip to May Beck. Car park at NZ 892 024 what3words Or to Harwood Dale SE 969 972 what3words	Follow the main forest trail up through the gate to the first junction. Further but can drive all the way and best views. Turn along forest trail to west of A171 just before first Ravenscar turning. Drive to the T junction and wait there.
Monday 26 th 10 am	Walk from Robin Hoods Bay along the old railway line to Stoupe Brow. Back along the cliff/beach (demanding) or the railway line (steady). Park at Station Car Park, RHB. NZ 949054 what3words YO22 4RE	Leader RM. C 9km walk but plenty of short cuts from railway line eg via Middleton Farm, Mark Lane or Mill Beck/Boggle Hole. Return walk along beach will be on falling tide.
